Doel (Belgium)

The authorities have resumed demolition in Doel - it is time for action

Officially the authorities would resume demolishing the most decrepit and irreparable houses, but Eva informed us they are also demolishing houses that are still in a perfect shape. It will probably be time for action now. Therefore Eva is trying to mobilize famous artists to make paintings on the walls of the empty houses to prevent the continuation of demolition since it will be more difficult for the authorities to take down houses with a painting of a really well-known artist. On the other hand she is organizing together with the UA (University of Antwerp) a major LD cookbook/pastries event in November, where recipes from the cookbook and some pastries will be served at the student restaurant, and there will be a reception in the "Meerminne Hall" where Pistoletto's ceiling sculptures are hanging. The definitive date and program will be decided in July with the new rector of the University.

Meanwhile the jewellery designer Danielle Goffa, who designed the Praliné Jewel is willing to try to design prototype jewels for all the pastries. She is also thinking about the possible materials she will use.

Lea had some lesson on the Kefte and the LDP



First she made an introduction on the LDP open call that she and Maria followed. Then she read the recipe of the Kefte to the children while they had to write it down. The kids were amazed by the existence of certain names of cities, which was a great geography lesson! She asked them to design the recipe on the same piece of paper, to draw the images that came to their minds, geography, food or process wise.

Some of their questions were how Lea and Maria converted kilometers into grams, how they managed to get all the 19 ingredients in one ball, how big the ball is and if they had to travel to all these cities in order to get the 19 ingredients.
