SELECTION PROCESS

FIRST AND SECOND EDITIONS

Cittadellarte and Artfactories selected the 6 artist group that participated to the second edition of *Methods* that tooke place in Arte Fiera in Bologna the 27-30 January 2006.

We received about 80 papers, so after reading all the papers we decided to follow some common parameter such as the project's methodology, **the connections and network created**, **the social transformation realized**, **the sustainability**, **the internation-ality and interdisciplinary**.

Using the word **methodology** we mean how the artists group working on the question of creative process within a social context, how they coordinate different aspects of the projects during years, how coordinate the people who work in the project, and how the social issue is develop in a interdisciplinary way. We evaluated also the theoretical aspect of the methodology, that is often careless.

A project create **connections** when there is a constant interaction with local communities, municipality, cultural foundations, EU, artist, people and other stakeholders. This parameter is also related to the fundraising aspect.

The **transformation of society** is a concrete change that occurred where the project taken place or in people involved in project. This parameter is harder to define and to evalued.

Sustainability, internationality and interdisciplinary were also essential requirement for the projects selected.
